RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY

AGREEMENT

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SIGN:

In consideration of being permitted to compete, officiate, work for, or participate in any way in the event(s) or being permitted to enter for any purpose any restricted area (requiring special authorization, credentials, or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), each of the undersigned, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he have or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect the restricted areas which he enters, and he further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he is in or about restricted areas and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and if necessary will leave the restricted areas and/or refuse to participate further in the event(s).
2. Hereby releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any restricted area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the events, premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or events and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releases," from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands there for on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned arising out of or related to the event(s), whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.
3. Hereby agrees to indemnify and save and hold harmless the releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur arising out of or related to the event(s) whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.
4. Hereby assumes full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death or property damage arising out of or related to the event(s) whether caused by the negligence of releases or otherwise.
5. Hereby acknowledges that the activities of the event(s) are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. Each of the undersigned, also expressly acknowledges that injuries received may be compounded or increased by negligent rescue operations or procedures of the releases.
6. Hereby agrees that this release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the releases, including negligent rescue operations and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the Province or State in which the event(s) is/are conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO ME AND INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.

TRUCK PULL RULES

Registration will close at 6:30PM * Mandatory Driver's Meeting at 6:45PM*

1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK OR THE SHOWGROUNDS!!!!
2. Any participant found possessing or consuming alcohol will be asked to leave the pull without a refund.
3. All drivers will have a valid (current) Operator's License.
4. One driver per truck per class - NO RIDERS
5. All vehicles will have properly installed seat belts which driver will use during pull.
6. NO SPECIAL FUEL such as NITRO or ALCOHOL will be used in ANY class except OPEN.
7. Tires SHALL NOT be equipped with studs, chains, lugs as tractor lugs, and no cut or grooved treads.
8. All hitches will be inspected. Judge shall have the rite to disqualify any vehicle with an unsafe hitch.
9. No snowplow blades allowed. Snowplow frames acceptable.
10. No added weight in ANY class except OPEN.
11. All pulls are to start from a tight hitch. NO jerking the sled to get started. NO CABLES ALLOWED.
12. In pulling, vehicles with standard transmission may NOT be shifted.
13. At conclusion of the event, all vehicles must be removed from the track and parked in designated area only.
14. All drivers must attend meeting before the pull.
15. Decisions by judges are FINAL.
16. Truck and sled must remain within course boundaries during pull.
17. No portion of truck shall interfere with sled during pull.
18. MUST pull a minimum of ten (10) feet to qualify to place.
19. Number one puller will be test puller and may take pull if weight transfer is deemed right, or immediately pull again.
20. DOT APPROVED HELMETS REQUIRED!
21. Registered vehicles must have proof of a valid inspection sticker and registration, and proof of insurance.
22. All hitches must have 2 x 2 hitch.
23. All trucks must have closed exhaust (mufflers), headers and dual exhaust O.K..
24. Upon entering race area, your truck will be charged for 1st pull (\$15.00). This includes entry for truck, driver, one crew member and 1st pull.
25. Drivers MUST stay at or near their vehicle at all times. If they do not proceed to line up when class is called their pull is forfeited and no refunds.
26. NO REFUNDS.
