


I'm Going to the Fair

### There will be so many things to see!










#### Sometimes, I will have to wait for my turn.




First, I wait.

# What else do you think you might smell?















There might be a lot of sounds at the fair.






#### What sounds do these animals make?

At the Sensory Safe Space, I can borrow headphones. I can say, "It's too loud."








At the Sensory Safe Space, I can take a deep breath.
